The Ministry of Women and Child Development has reported that in 2016, 19,223 women and children were trafficked in India constituting a rise of almost 25% from the previous year, West Bengal being one of the top states for trafficked victims.

Within Bengal, South 24 Parganas features among the top five districts in terms of trafficking. Most of the girls who are trafficked are lured from their homes with the false promise of an opportunity for employment. Even when girls are rescued and brought back, the biggest obstacle they face is lack of gainful occupation.

This is why MISSING believes that to root out trafficking, it is crucial to provide livelihood opportunities in high trafficking areas.





The Missing Link Trust rural livelihood program, through its Women Empowerment Centre (WEC) aims to create awareness in villages of Kultali amongst rescued women and vulnerable girls, creating a base to introduce them to means of alternate livelihood options.

Through the awareness sessions, Missing Link Trust identifies girls who are either survivors of trafficking, victims of child marriage or domestic violence, or girls who are vulnerable to trafficking.

It further empowers vulnerable girls and build their capacity to become self-reliant through stitching, tailoring and bag making skills.
